

### **NetWork Volunteers**

NetWork Volunteer will work with the Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE) fraternity to organize a day of service in August, 2017. This TKE Day of Service will engage around 450 volunteers and will focus on improvements to five different community organizations in Central City, New Orleans.

### **Rebuilding Together New Orleans**

Rebuilding Together New Orleans will engage around 270 volunteers this summer to finish an existing home project affected by the February tornado and also to begin prepping other home projects in the New Orleans area for an annual build event. Volunteers will assist with scraping paint and priming, replacing and repairing siding, framing out a wheelchair ramp, framing stairs, setting posts and framing a fence.

### **All Hands Volunteers**

All Hands Volunteers will engage around 1200 volunteers this summer to complete 15 homes in Livingston, Ascension, and East Baton Rouge Parishes that were affected by the August floods. The grant will help support volunteer housing and transportation needs, and the volunteers will assist with painting, flooring, installing trim, baseboards, doors and cabinets.

### **Camp Noah**

Camp Noah is a program of Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota that teaches resiliency and preparedness skills to children whose lives have been affected by disasters. Camp Noah will host two camps this summer in Baton Rouge for children in grades K-6, engaging around 30 local volunteers to assist in facilitating the camps. The camps will focus on learning and building resiliency skills in a safe, caring, and structured environment emphasizing hope and healing.

### **SBP**

SBP will engage around 250 volunteers this summer to work on completing two homes in East Baton Rouge Parish affected by the August floods. Volunteers will assist with finishing drywall, priming and painting, and installing flooring, trim, and doors.

### **NOLA Tree Project**

NOLA Tree Project will engage around 200 volunteers this summer to continue rebuilding four homes in New Orleans East that were damaged by the tornado in February. Volunteers will work on debris removal, installation of insulation and sheetrock, flooring, trim-carpentry, and painting.

### **Fuller Center Disaster Rebuilders**

Fuller Center Disaster Rebuilders will engage around 150 volunteers this summer to continue rebuilding homes in Livingston and Tangipahoa Parishes that were affected by the August

floods. This grant will also assist Fuller Center with housing needs for their volunteers working on the home projects.

### **Rebuilding Together Baton Rouge**

Rebuilding Together Baton Rouge will engage around 60 volunteers this summer to help complete a home in East Baton Rouge Parish affected by the August floods. Volunteers will assist with painting, completing bathrooms, moldings, and doors for the home.

### **True Light Baptist Church**

True Light Baptist church will engage around 300 volunteers this summer to help rebuild homes in East Baton Rouge Parish affected by the August Floods. Volunteers will assist with replacing flooring, painting, drywall, lawn care and other needs within the community.
